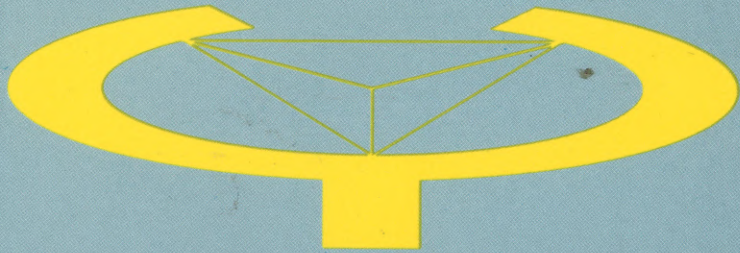
Throughout the band's history Jon's compositional vocal and band management skills have been a vital part of the YES make up and success.

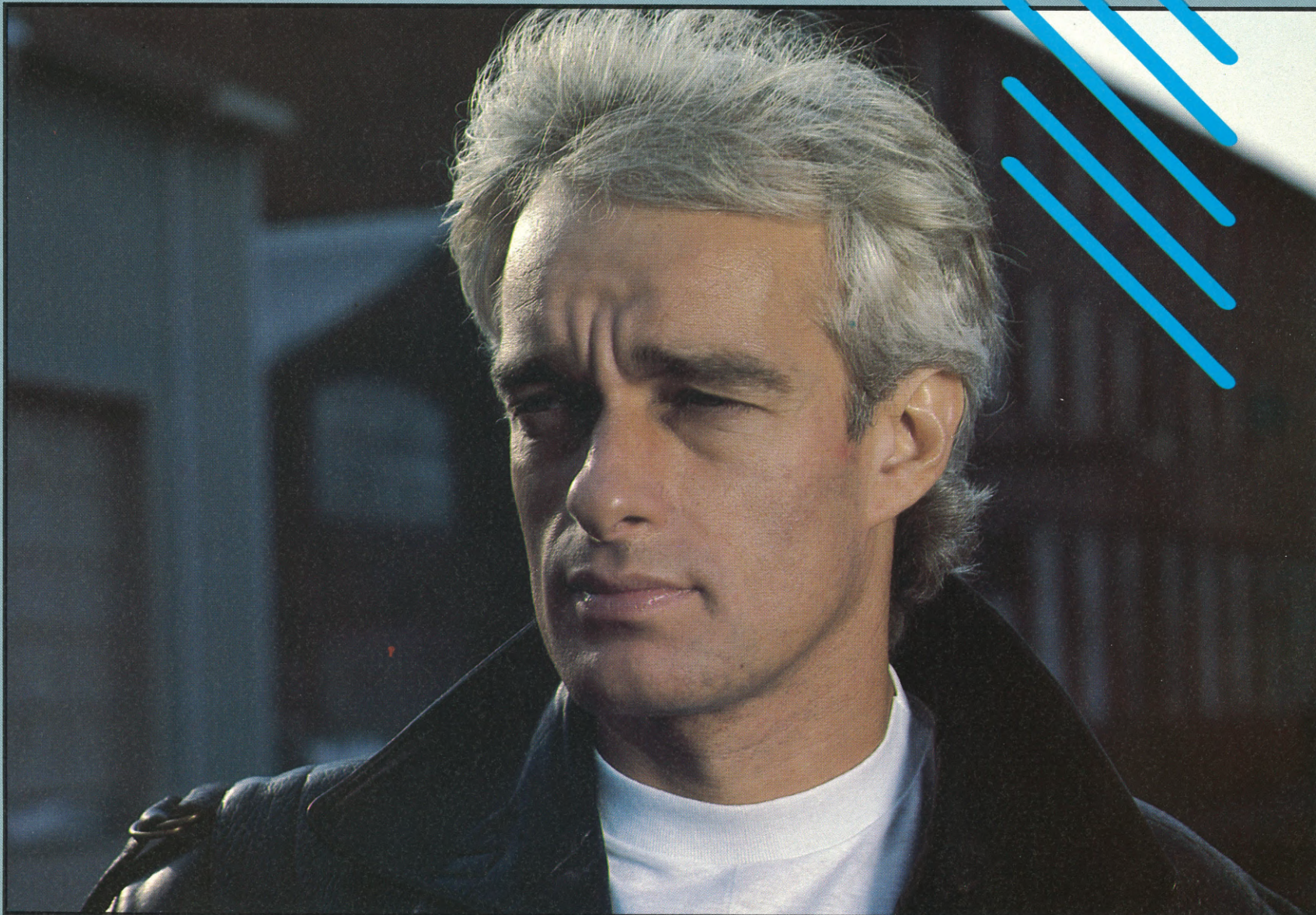
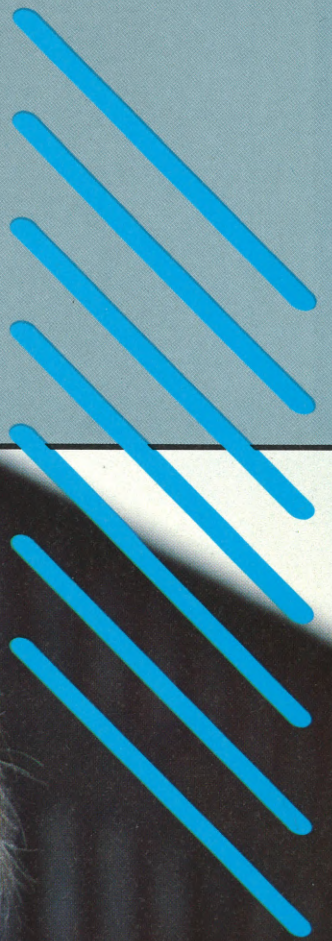






T O N Y K A Y E

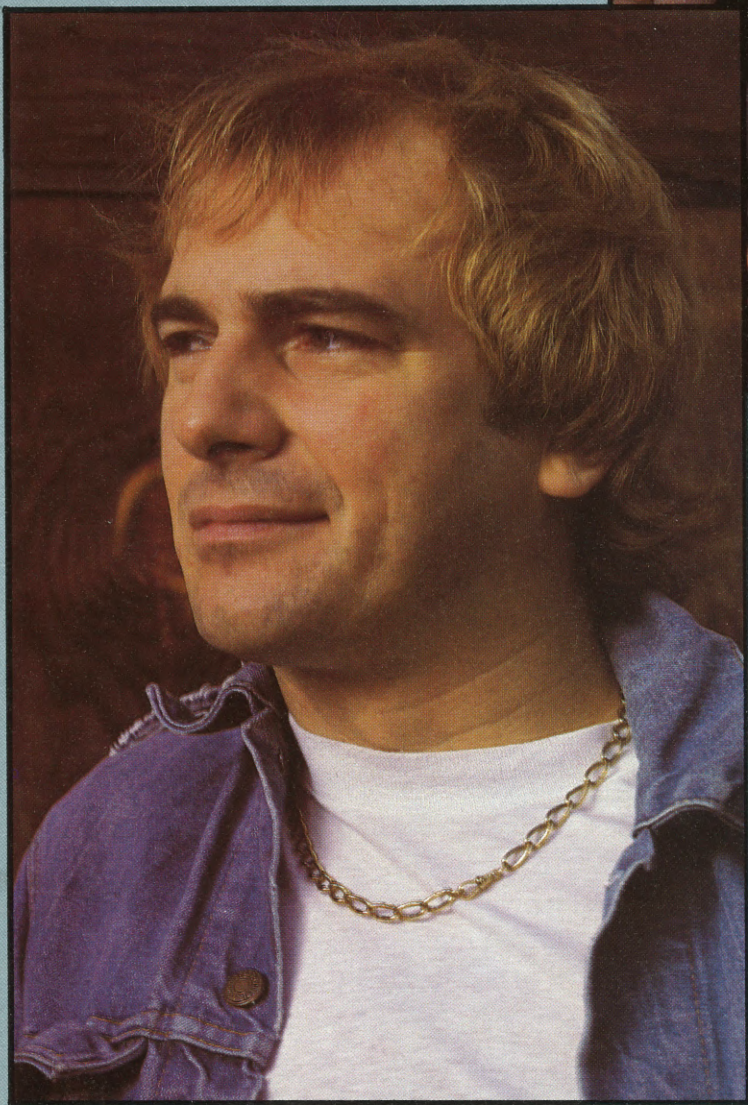
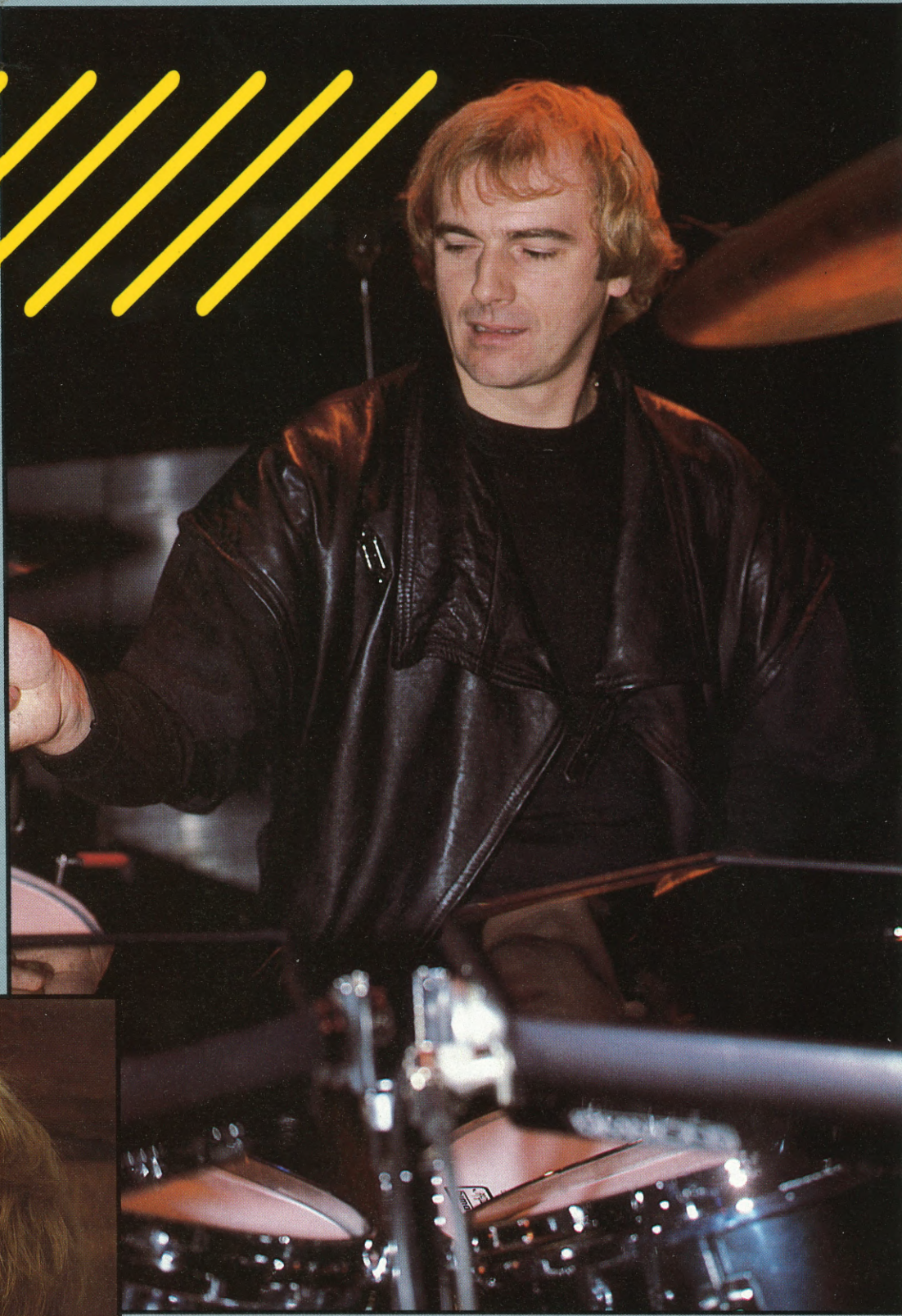
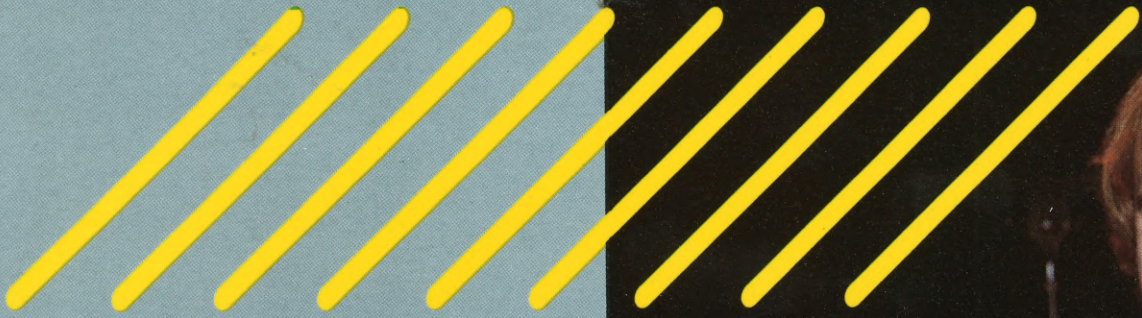




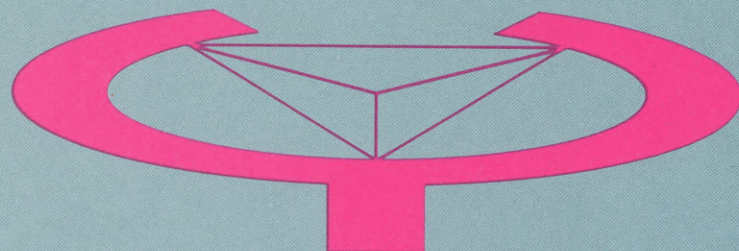
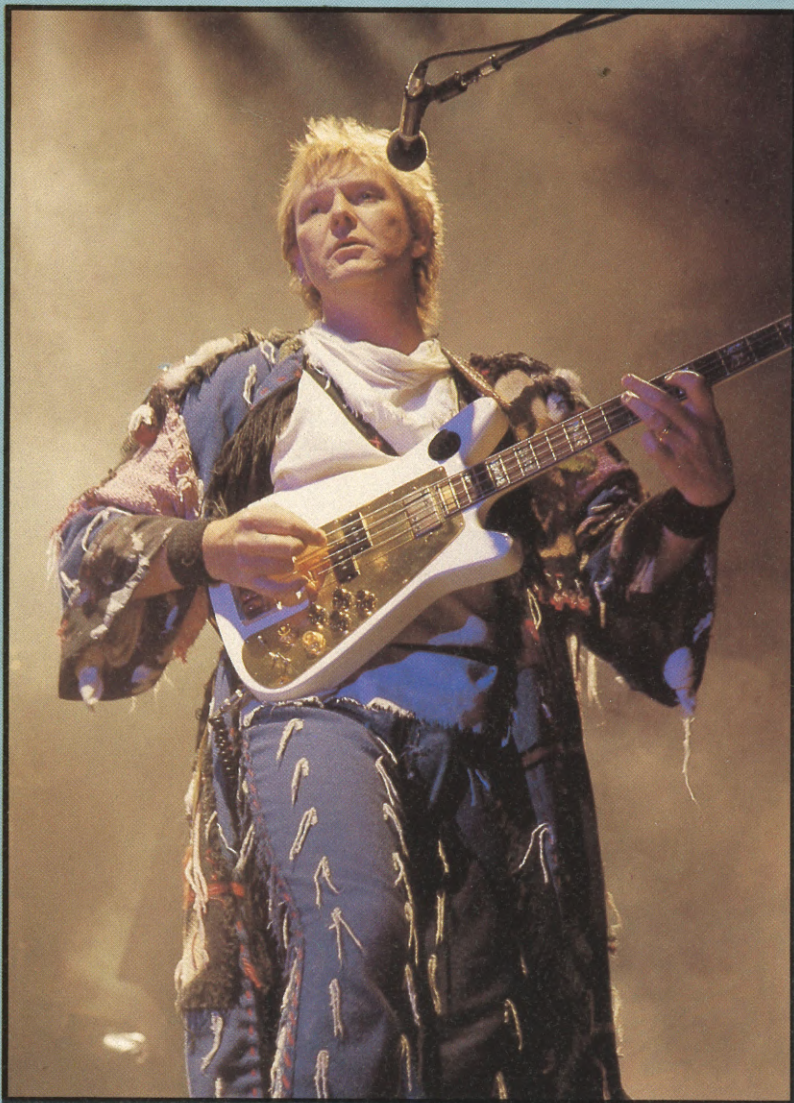
ALAN WHITE

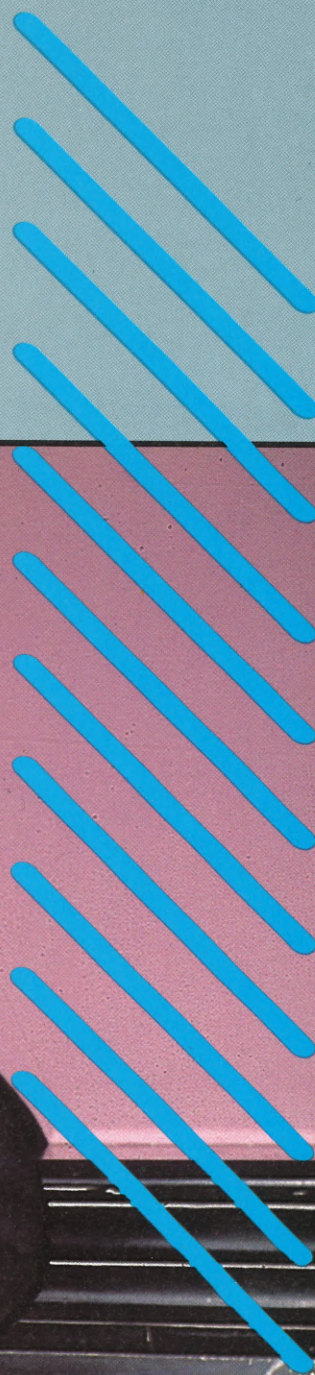


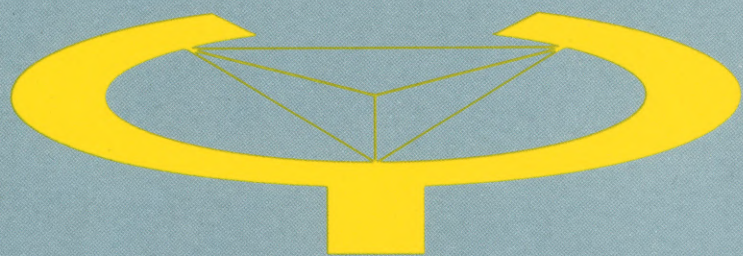
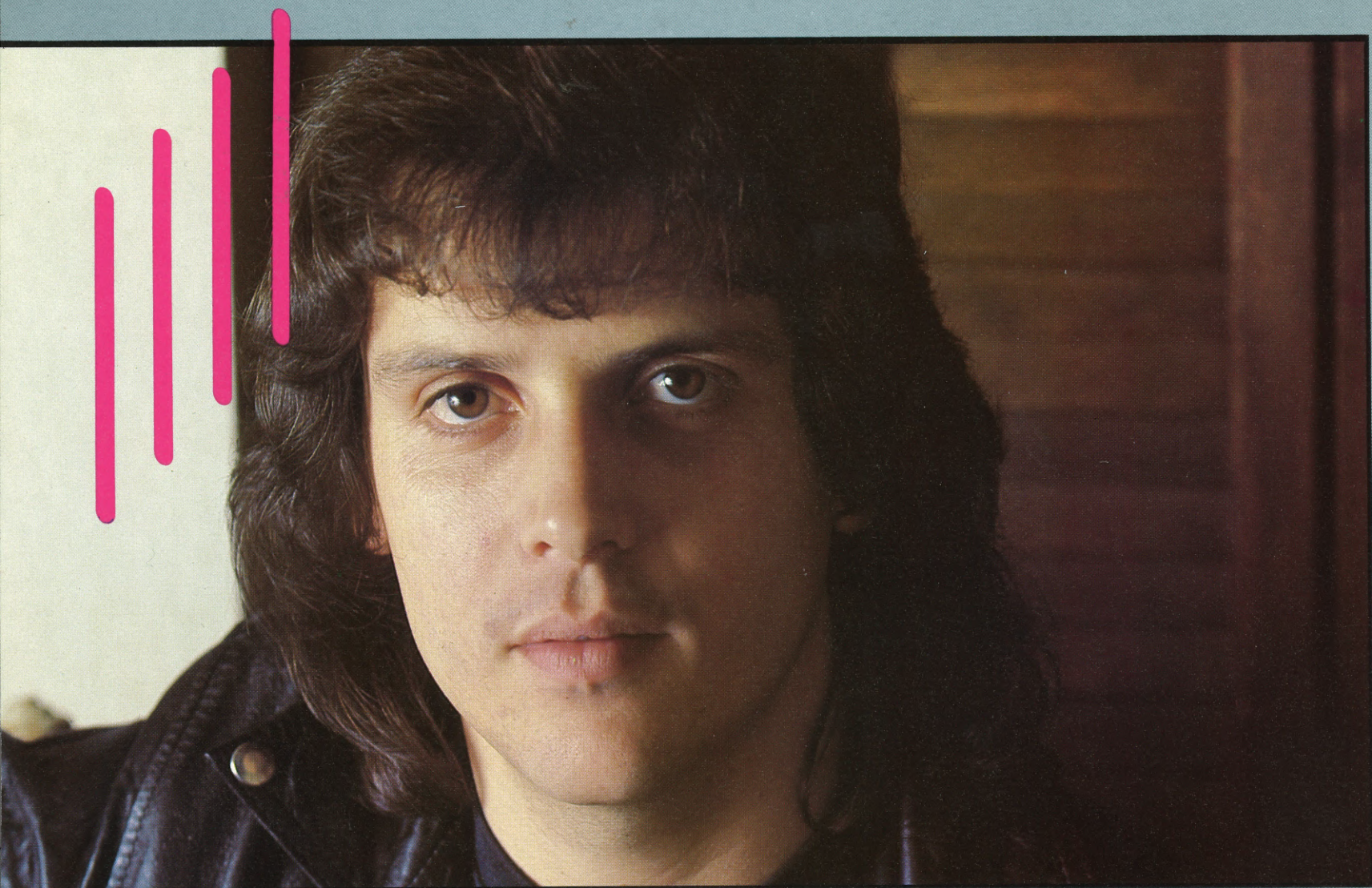


CHRIS SQUIRE

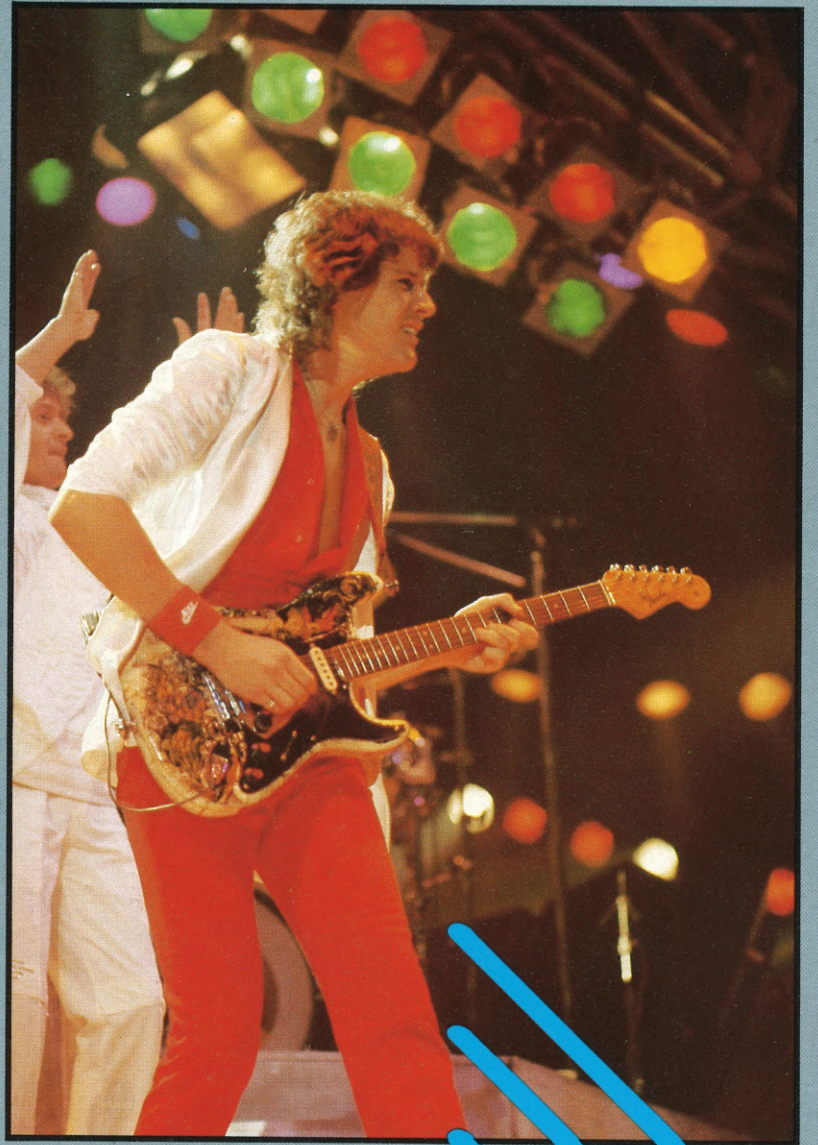
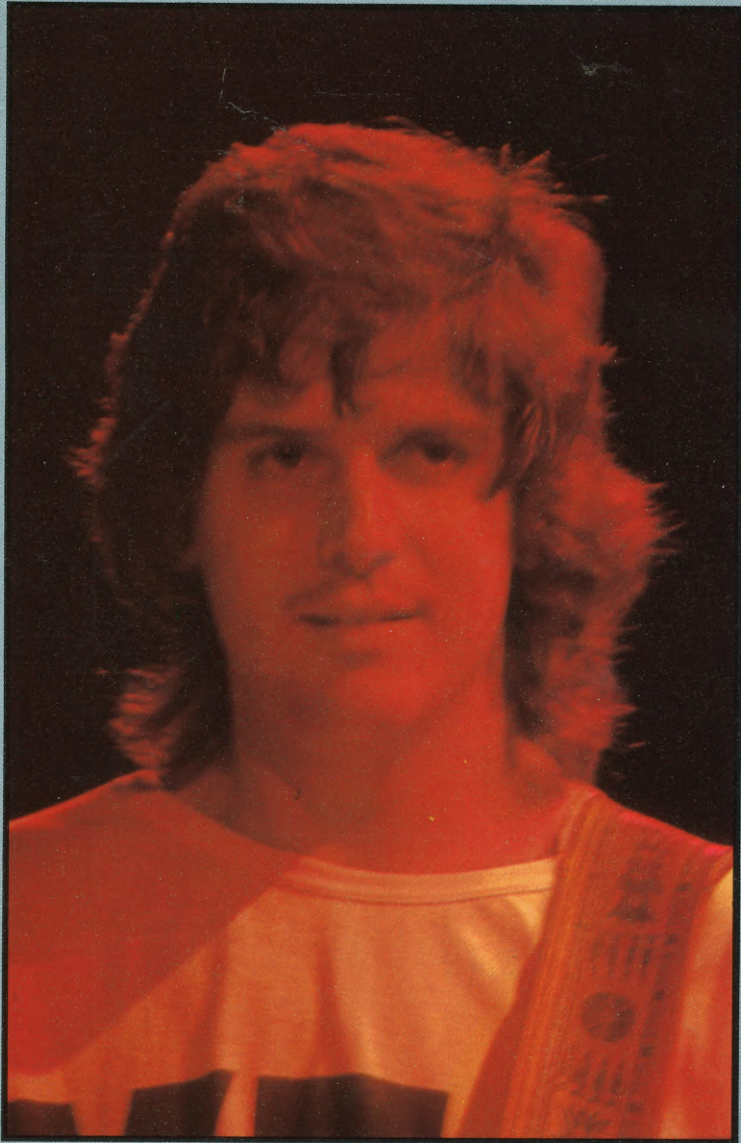
But notwithstanding this, as cofounder and an integral part of YES, he has become one of the most influential innovators of rock, always pushing it to the outer limits.
