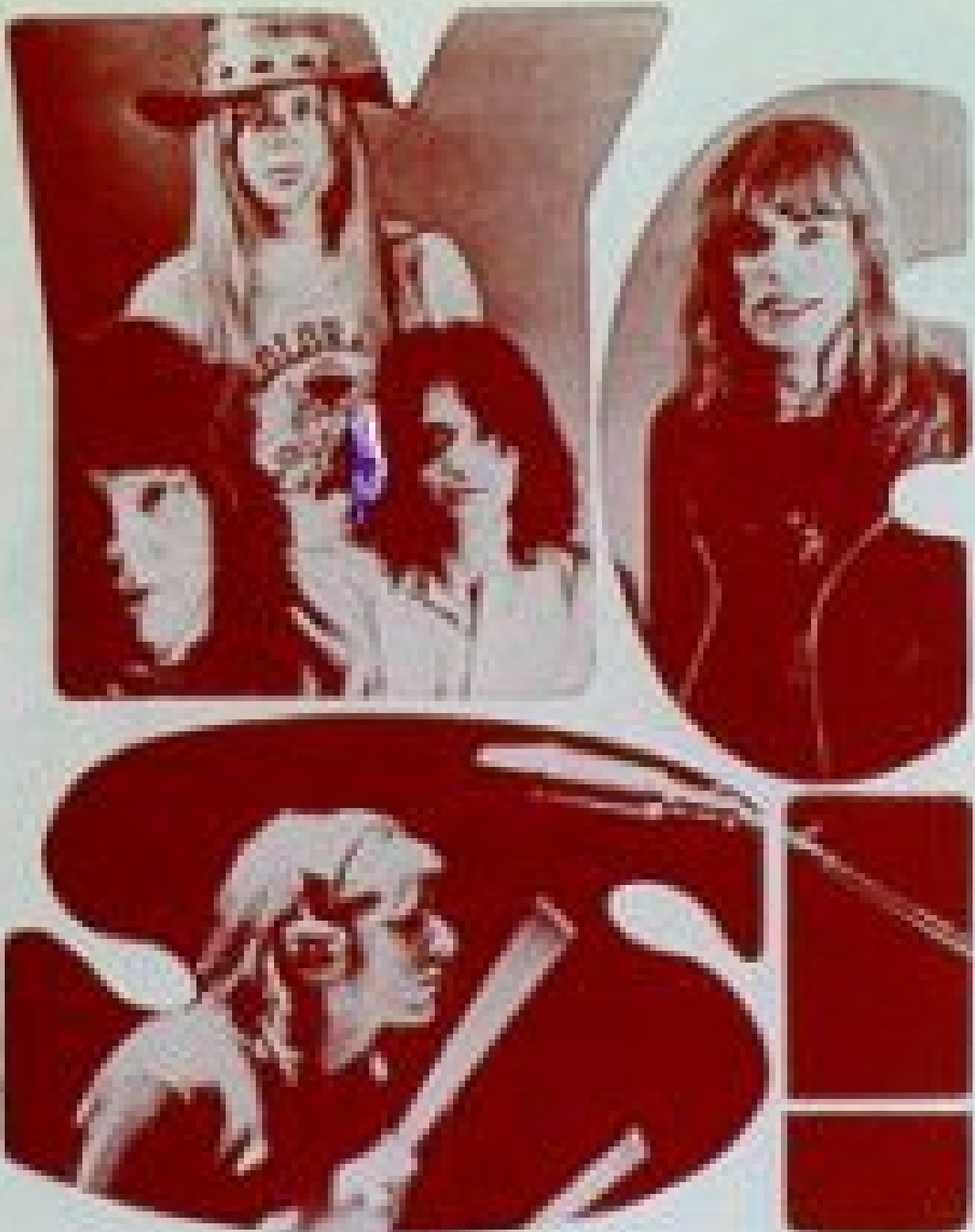

The members of the Phi Kappa Psi:

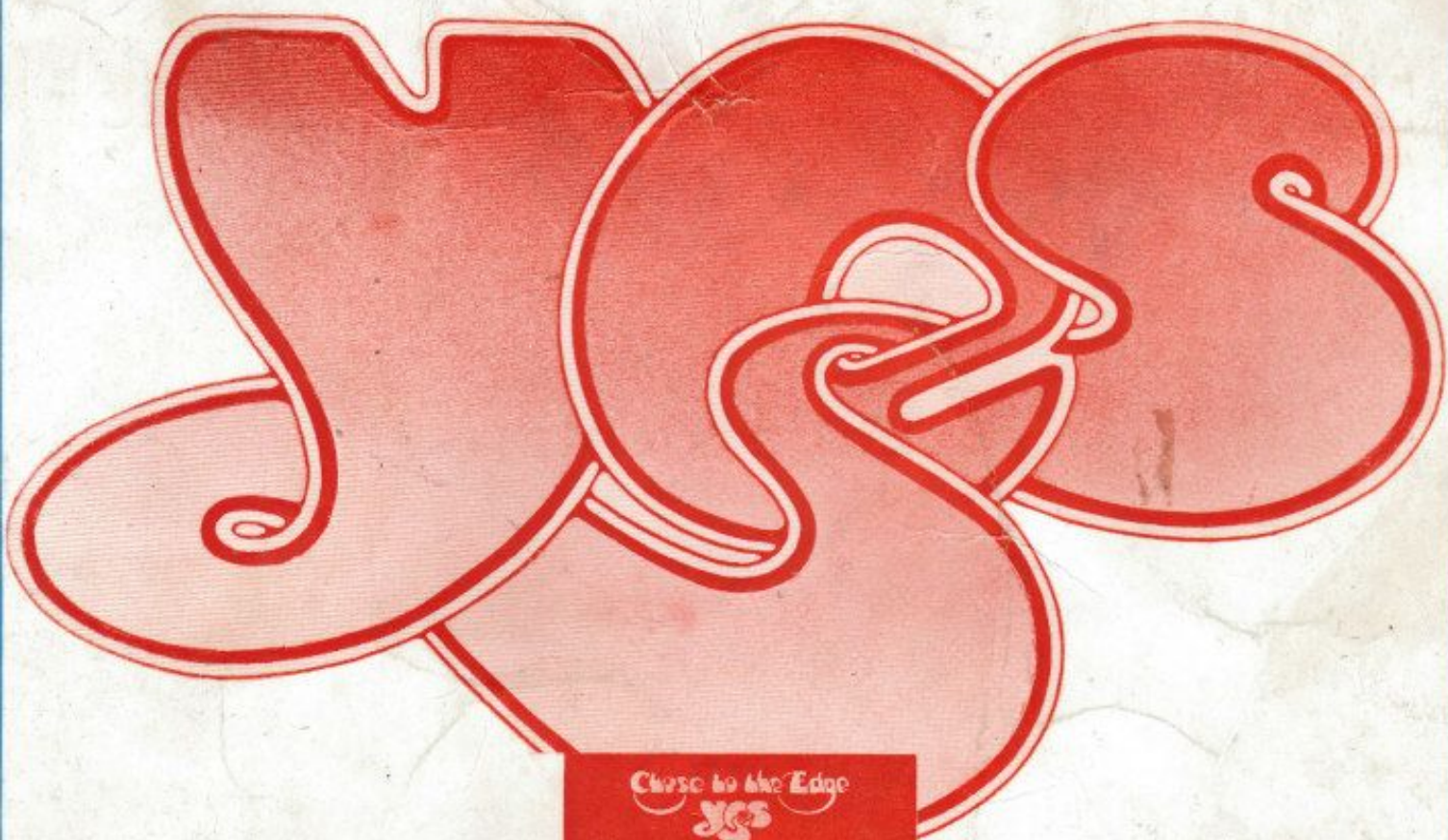
JOE ANDERSON, class singer, and who carries the bulk of the group's record.
